FROM A YEAR OF HOPE TO A YEAR OF LIFE

In this hope
we were saved.
But hope is that

Who hopes for

For if we hope for what we do not

Romans 8, 24-25

While writing this in early June, I am very aware that everything in July and August may be much different from what I expect it to be right now.

For the past 16 months, I have told myself that this pandemic cannot last that much longer. The refrain for me during this pandemic has been "next month...next month...next month and everything will be freer and we will all get together again for real."

Alas, during the last 12 months, all my predictions of a quick re-opening have failed. We have been restricted and closed down for so long. Has it been foolish of me to hope for a quick resolution of the pandemic? If I had been wiser and stuck to my sense of reality, I would soon have concluded that we could not predict the course of this virus and that we better not hope for any quick

solutions. At least not a quick re-opening. After all, we never know the future and maybe we should be prepared to settle for less. Maybe we should equip ourselves with patience and perseverance and perhaps even expect the worst, which would be a fourth wave.

However, I don't believe that I would have survived mentally if I hadn't kept my spirits up and hoped for next month to be better. I really do believe that hope has saved me through many tough moments, even if I at times couldn't realistically see an end to the pandemic in the near future. Hope gave me strength to wait

patiently for the freedom and togetherness that we have not had for such long time.

I would have despaired, I would have become depressed, I would have stopped renewing my life, if I had not hoped for a better tomorrow. Of course, to hope was perhaps not seen as the wisest and most reasonable thing to do, but it was the right thing to do.







See you at church and see you out there in our wonderful summer




