BÆRER HVERANDRES BYRDER

March is usually the time of Lent. For 40 days before Easter, we are supposed to abstain from those things that are not necessary. Many don't eat meat, alcohol and sugar among other things. I know that most of you in this congregation probably don't observe lent. And rightly so, as there are enough burdens in this life to carry and enough sacrifices to make. We don't need to observe Lent, do penance and add self-punishment to all the challenges in life.

At the time of the reformation, life was even more challenging than today. Life was harsher with less conveniences and more struggles. Nevertheless, many people imposed upon themselves even more hardships, as they believed they could please God with self-inflicted pain. Our reformer, Martin Luther, on the other hand, concluded that people already have enough distress in their lives. We don't have to add to the troubles. No, life was, according to Martin Luther, a penance in its own right, and there was therefore no need for a special time of year for contrition. For that reason, Lent slowly went out of use in the Lutheran world.

To me, though, Lent offers an opportunity to cut back on all the superfluous stuff and conduct in our lives. There is lots of redundant stuff and behaviour in our world today! Of course, we should be mindful of our conduct and our focus every day of our lives. God has given us our days and years to use through meaningful relationships and in the enjoyment of His good creation, not to waste them on unnecessary and pointless behaviour and striving for more stuff. But in our epoque of abundance and affluence, it is perhaps more urgent than ever to become more aware of what is truly important in life and what is not, what we need and what is redundant. That is why the tradition of Lent may help us to a

new focus in life if we use the abstention wisely and don't expect miracles "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ."

Galatians 6, 2

from our own efforts.

I know that many people have enough troubles in their lives. They don't need to impose more challenges on themselves. I meet them every day. People who have lost. People who are sick. People who are confused or in misfortune. They do not need to add to their challenges. No, instead they need our help, attention and support. Fortunately, I know many here in this congregation who do their share of the care -many who visit, help and support those in need. I know many who live by the motto of our Church, "Bærer Hverandres Byrder" - "Carry each other's burdens". I am proud to be the pastor of all these supportive parishioners as there are more than enough people to help and enough sacrifices to make just by attending and caring for the many in need. With this care and love for one another, I believe that we vicariously live out the penance and atonement to the entire world.

Therefore, observe Lent if you need more awareness of what is essential in your life. But more important than abstaining from meat, alcohol or sugar, we should try to live by the motto of our Church: "Bærer hverandres byrder"; "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way fulfill the law of Christ" in the expectation of a happy Easter, a resurrection to new life and new hope for everyone on this planet.





Please register the DVDs you borrow and bring them back in undamaged shape for others to enjoy.



Membership

How does one get to be a member of Ansgar Danish Lutheran Church? Membership is a broad term as anyone who attends a church service is a member of the congregation at the time. An official Member of Ansgar Danish Lutheran Church of Edmonton is more defined than that and is:

- A person who has been baptized or confirmed at ADLC is a member.
- A person who
 - has been baptized in the name of God
 - accepts this Constitution and Bylaws
 - has requested (to the current or previous pastor or Board) to be a member, and has been accepted is a member.

Members are entitled to vote on Church matters. A Member of ADLC cannot be a registered member of another Congregation. Of course, anyone can attend service at another church any time. The Societies Act of Alberta 2000 requires Membership Register including the full name and street address of the member be kept. It is a big job to keep up with address changes and it isn't at the top of the list for people to inform the church when they move, so every few years. the Board sends out questionnaires to keep our Register up to date.
